Chapter author (s): Give the last name and name as presented in the source (e. g. Watson, John). For two authors, reverse only the first name, followed by & and the second name in normal order (e. g. Watson, John, and John Watson). For three or more authors, list the first name followed by et al. (e. g. Watson, John, et al.)

To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in Harvard style include the following elements:. Author(s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J.) of up to three authors with the last name preceded by 'and'. When citing a section of a book, you include the author's name followed by the title of the section or chapter enclosed in quotation marks. The italicized title of the complete work/book comes next after the word *in*.

If you want to cite a book chapter in APA format, you need to include the chapter author's name either in the introductory phrase before the quote or in the parenthetical citation after it, along with the publication date and page number.

Citing a Chapter in the APA Format Citing a chapter in the APA format is the trickiest part, because edited books are a collection of different chapters from different authors and different books. Even the slightest slip-up can result in you citing the wrong author with the chapter, so it is necessary to be careful to avoid any plagiarism.

To cite the entire anthology or collection, list by editor (s) followed by a comma and "editor" or, for multiple editors, "editors." This sort of entry is somewhat rare. If you are citing a particular piece within an anthology or collection (more common), see A Work in an Anthology, Reference, or Collection below.

A chapter in an authored ebook from an academic collection should be treated as a chapter in an authored print book with the reference ending with the publisher. For a chapter in an authored print book or ebook with a DOI, see Chapter in an Authored Book with a DOI.

Cite a Chapter in MLA: Edited books An edited book incorporates chapters that are completed by authors different from editors. When citing a piece from an edited book, the writer's name is displayed first, followed by the title of the section.
